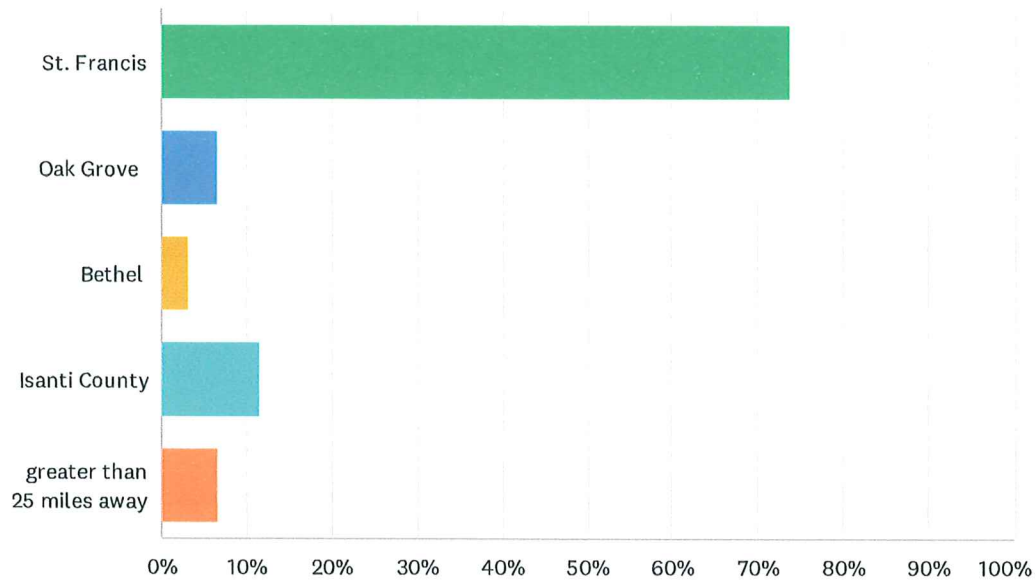


Q1 What city do you currently reside?

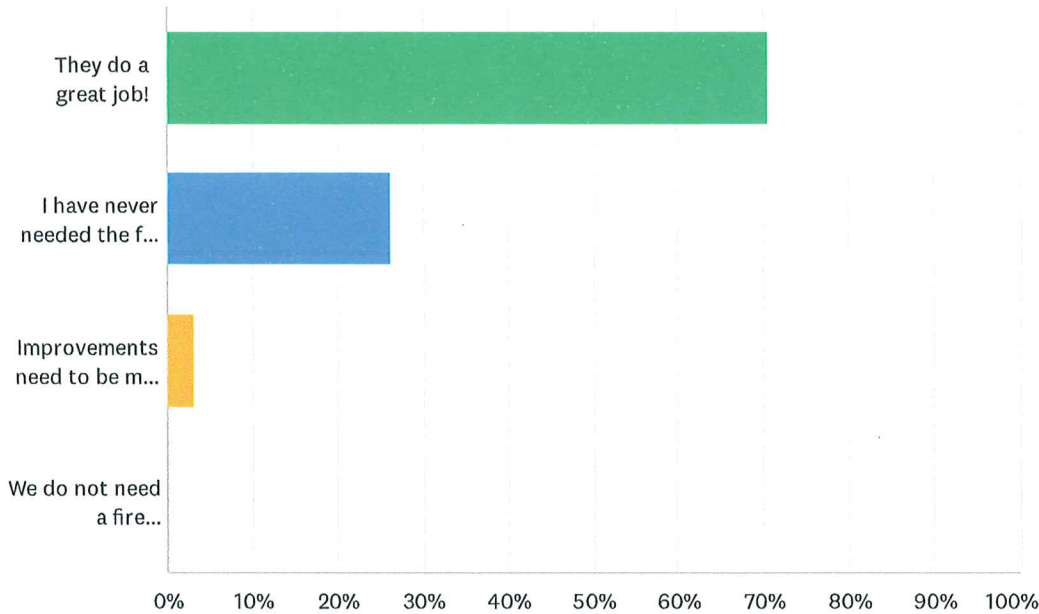

Q2 How do you feel about your local fire department emergency services?

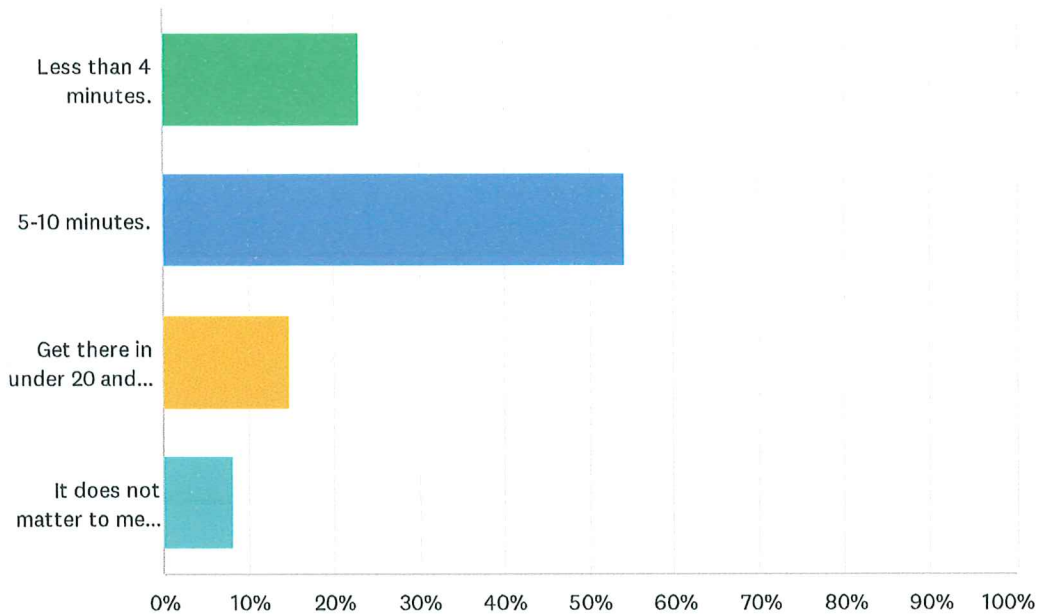

Q3 How fast should a fire truck arrive to an emergency?

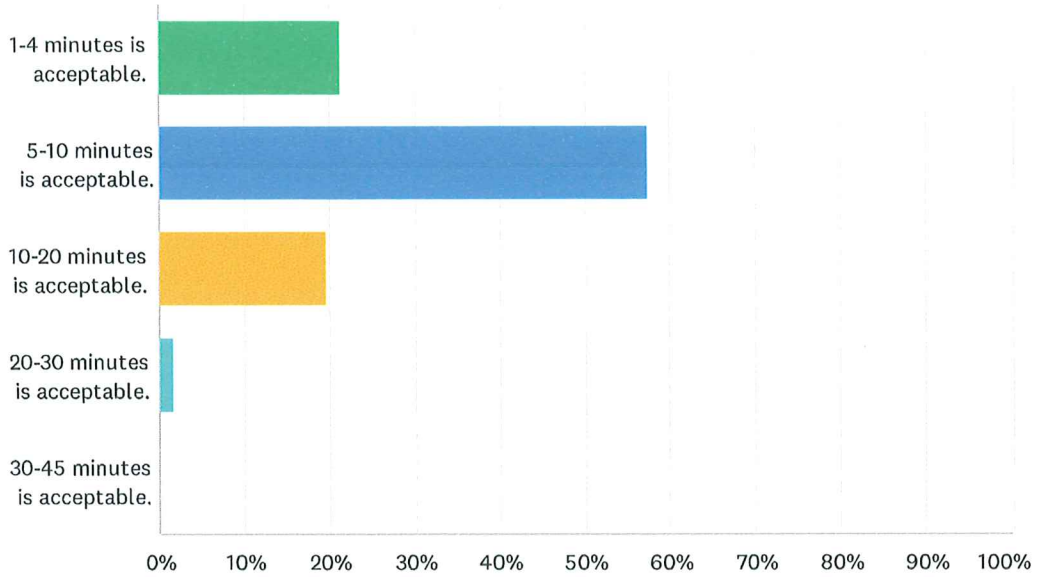

Q4 How fast should an ambulance take to arrive to your medical emergency?

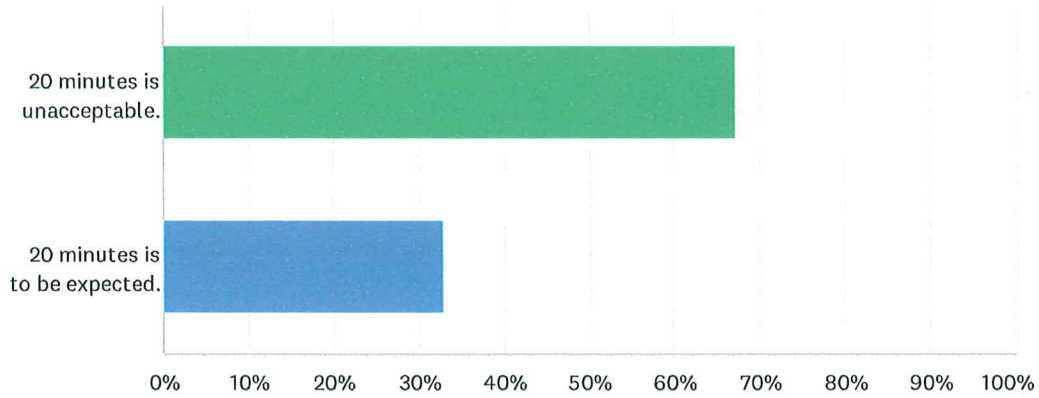

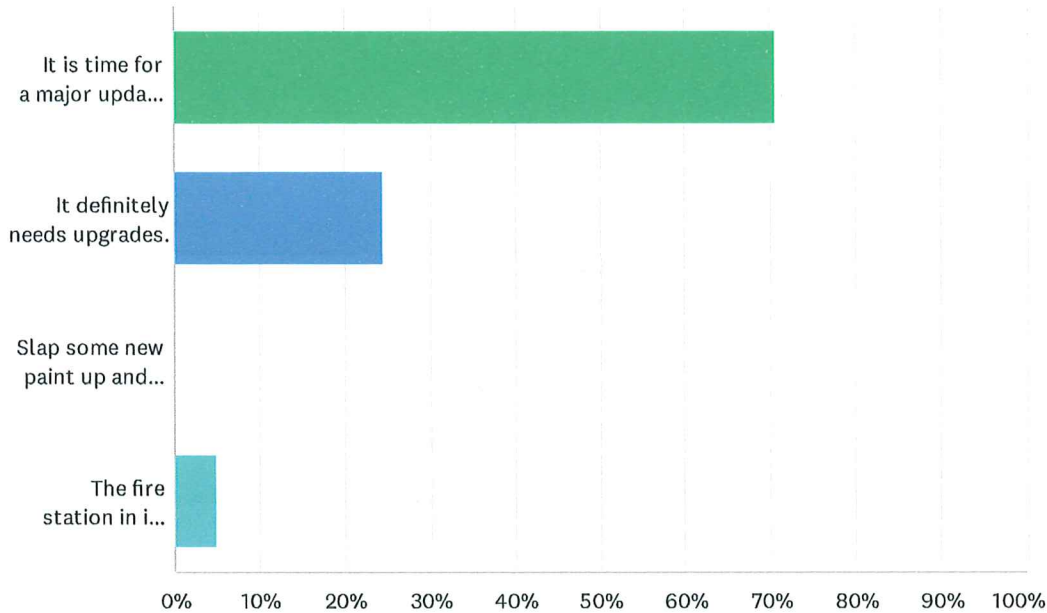

Q6 The current fire station is approaching 60 years old. It has been remodeled from a smaller older police station. As a member of the community what is your impression of the fire station?

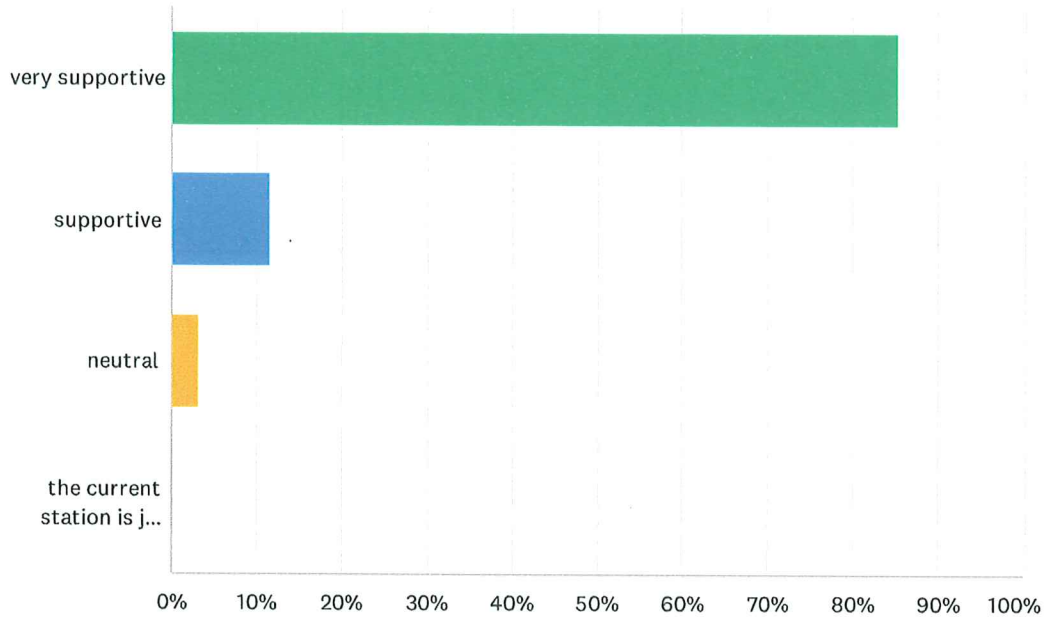
