

COLLECTION EVENT DETAILS

DAY OF EVENT:

- 1. Securely place items into your trunk or cargo bed, bring drivers license or proof of residency.
- 2. Enter event from 227th Ave NW
- 3. Remain in your vehicle while staff unload accepted items.
